

Guidelines for Online Behavior

All students participating in the JRU-CRP classes must agree to abide by the following code of conduct as a reflection of the Rizalian Core Values of Responsibility, Consideration and Courtesy, and Integrity:

1. I will be responsible for securing my log-in details (username and password).
2. My answers to homework, forums, quizzes and exams will be my own work (except for assignments that explicitly permit student collaboration).
3. I will not make solutions to homework, quizzes or exams available to anyone else.
4. I will not use someone else's name and pretend to be them.
5. I will not engage in any other activities that will dishonestly improve my results or dishonestly improve/hurt the results of others.
6. I will follow other rules of netiquettes for online correspondence and communication:
 1. I will spell check and proof read my internet correspondence
 2. I will only use appropriate language for discussion (non-abusive, non-threatening, non-racist)
 3. I will not use ALL CAPS
 4. I will tell the truth online
 5. I will not post insulting response about others or respond to insults
 6. I will not spam with repeated messages
 7. I will refrain myself from sending unsolicited messages
 8. I will be discrete and conservative in my online communication
 9. I will not post or distribute material that is deemed illegal
