



Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs):

Q: How can I do the online tasks if I don't have a computer and internet at home?

A: You can go to the computer laboratories to check your computer and open lab schedule. You can also use the library computer units. The library and student lounge at the canteen also have wi-fi access.

Q: What if I missed the online tasks?

A: Ask your teacher if he can extend the submission or quiz deadline.

Q: What if I forgot my password?

A: You can go to the IT Office at H-409 or approach a Student Assistant in the computer laboratory to have your password reset.

Q: I can't seem to access Moodle at home?

A: Make sure that you are in the correct site and have a stable internet connection. Make sure as well that you enter the right username and password.

2. Computer laboratories should be used only for academic purposes. Proper conduct and discipline as stated in the student manual is expected from everyone at all times inside the computer laboratory.

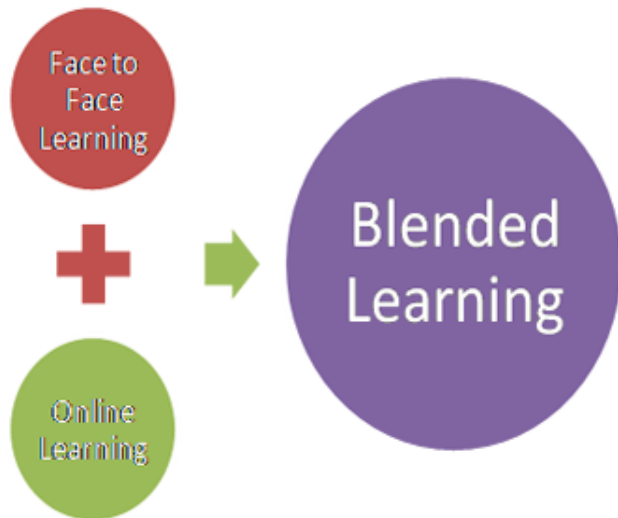

What is Blended Learning?

Blended Learning is the thoughtful fusion or combination of face-to-face (F2F) learning and online learning.



In a Blended Learning Course, you only meet with your teacher inside the classroom once a week. The other session is for you to accomplish the tasks and activities in the online module.

50% - Online
